

Countertop Wine Opener

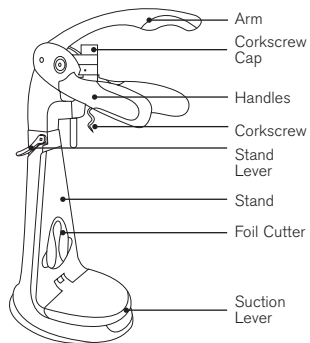

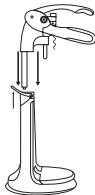

LOCATION OF PARTS



ASSEMBLING THE WINE OPENER

1. Raise the Stand Lever halfway and insert the top section of the opener into the Stand, with the Handles over the base.



NOTE: The top section can be inserted fully or part way to accommodate different size bottles.

2. Lower the Stand Lever, securing the top section into the Stand.

PREPARING THE OPENER FOR USE

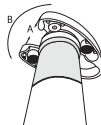
1. Place the opener on a flat, clean surface.
2. Raise the Suction Lever.
3. Hold the opener by the Stand and press down firmly while lowering the Suction Lever.



USING THE FOIL CUTTER

1. Remove the Foil Cutter from the Stand. Caution: The Foil Cutter contains sharp cutting wheels. Use caution when handling.

2. Place the Foil Cutter over the top of the bottle. Ensure that the two cutting wheels make contact with the foil.



3. Squeeze the Foil Cutter gently (A) and fully twist around the bottle (B), ensuring that the foil is completely scored.

4. Lift the Foil Cutter off the bottle and remove the foil to expose the cork. Place the Foil Cutter back in the Stand.

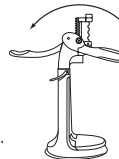
NOTE:

- Do not force the Foil Cutter open.
- Do not try to fit the Foil Cutter around the neck of the bottle.
- If a wax cover protects the cork, remove the wax with a knife. This will prevent build-up of wax on the corkscrew.

OPENING YOUR BOTTLE OF WINE

1. Remove the foil using the Foil Cutter, as described previously.

2. Fully extend the Arm to raise the Corkscrew.



3. Place your wine bottle on the Stand. Squeeze the two Handles to securely hold the top of the bottle neck. The Corkscrew should be positioned over the cork.

4. Pull the Arm up and over the bottle. The Corkscrew will enter the cork. *Be sure to pull the Arm all the way down, to fully insert the Corkscrew into the cork.*



5. Tightly squeeze the Handles with one hand and lift the Arm to remove the cork from the bottle.

6. Hold the bottle, release the Handles, and remove the wine bottle from the Stand.

RELEASING THE CORK

1. Spread the Handles slightly while bringing the Arm up and over the Stand.




2. Squeeze the Handles together tightly and lift the Arm up and back over the Stand to release the cork from the Corkscrew.



NOTE: If the cork does not release or stops between the Handles, repeat this procedure.

REPLACING THE CORKSCREW

1. Raise the Arm up and over the Stand.
- 
2. Unscrew the Corkscrew Cap.
3. Turn the Corkscrew counterclockwise. The Corkscrew will rise out of the mechanism.
4. Remove the Corkscrew.
5. Insert the new Corkscrew, aligning it carefully in the mechanism. Turn the Corkscrew clockwise if necessary to insert completely.
6. Replace the Corkscrew Cap and turn clockwise to tighten securely.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Clean with a damp cloth. Do not submerge in water.
